## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

All involved parties will help shape the final report on the problems with organic waste management and the potential solutions put forth by the project.



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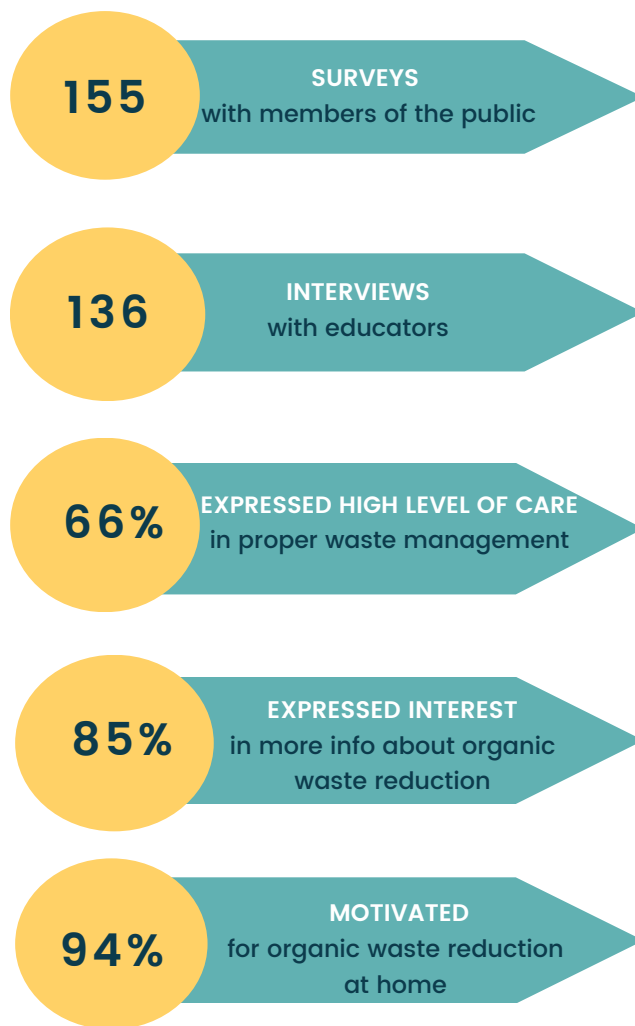
